Our Executive Committee takes pleasure in presenting Annual Report for the year ending 31st March 2010 along with Audited Annual Accounts for the year ended on that date. During the year under review, the following are our achievements.

ACTIVITIES & PROGRAMMES

CHILD LABOUR AWARENESS PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. The initiatives and support for the Eradication of Child Labour in India, through the government sector, non-government sector, judiciary, social workers and public at large has raised hopes for creating mass movement against the menace of child labour and provide universal compulsory education for children. Several legislations have been passed from time to time to prohibit or improve the working conditions of child labour.

A Child Labour Technical Advisory Committee has been setup to advise the Central Government in addition of occupations and processes to the schedule contained in the child labour. The committee was empowered to undertake reviews and frame rules as necessary to ensure that the work is regulated in accordance with part.

Two pronged strategy i.e. direct action (raids, rescue operation, consumers awareness Programmes, rehabilitation etc.) and indirect Action (campaigns, marches, demonstration and seminar and workshop) are being adopted for the crusade against bonded child labour and child servitude.

GIRLS EDUCATION PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. The organization conducted the girls education programme for the rural girls and women. Adolescent girls and matured girls are educated and trained by the organization to develop the business skills and production of commercial goods in their own home. Education especially for women is an important agent of socialization, and instrument of social transformation, and a channel of social mobility and equity. Education of girls and women has to be a universal movement for

their empowerment, for changing current stereo-typed and replacing the existing structures.

Within an overall orientation toward girls' education, OUR organisation is running this Programme being one of the parts of overall strategy of universalisation of Elementary Education.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. OUR Organization has been running vocational training programme for welfare women, child and youths belonging to the informal economy. It is not just an organization but also a confluence of three movements- labour, self-reliance and self-employment. Our Society started vocational training programme to encourage self-reliance and self-employment for women and youths who were unemployed and searching job. In this programme Society started all educated and uneducated persons in view of their requirements. Under vocational training programme our Society-started computer training, typing, handcrafting, tailoring-sewing, weaving, painting, T.V., Transistor and Tape-recorder repairing programmes.

CULTURAL PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. To preserve our rich cultural heritage and traditions we organized dance, folk-song, drama etc. in which young and children participated in good number. Participants were also awarded for their presentation. In this programme our through the society attained renowned theatre actors & actress and show their programmes like Ramlila Harishchandra Natak and other classical & folk programmes.

Drama, Dance competition, folk art festivals, Music etc. cultural show competition organized by society for entertainment of people and their welfare. Apart this a meeting organized of folk artists on the Gandhi Jayanti. The culture of a country is regarded as accumulated intellectual, emotional and spiritual wealth of that nation. The present day our culture seems to be falling down, so we have the responsibility to sustain our culture and tradition through anyway whether we can do, so we organized many Programmes for it.

WOMEN'S AWARENESS CAMP

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. Our NGO believes that economic empowerment of women transforms them into powerful agents of social change. NGO, women's

empowerment programme is helping several thousand rural women like Sarita add to their family income. NGO organizes rural women into micro-credit groups and provides them funds to build and manage a revolving development fund. Enhancing their employability to supplement family income. Leading to better health care, nutrition and education for their children.

NGO women's empowerment programme emanates from its aspiration to create enduring value for the nation. For NGO, it is yet another expression of a commitment beyond the market. ENVIRONMENT AWARENESS CAMP

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. The Environmental pollution menace is one of the most serious problems, which world is facing today. Our environment is getting more and more degraded with every passing day. Nature has blessed us with the environment, which is free of all pollutants. But man has indiscriminately been cruel with himself by polluting the environment, which sustains all life. Environmental pollution is normally of three kinds: (1) air pollution (2) water pollution (3) noise pollution. Our air is being contaminated by the smoke emitted by chimneys of factories, the exhaust gases emitted by automobiles and the nuclear explosions carried out by certain big military powers. The amount of carbon dioxide and sulphur dioxide is increasing beyond permissible limits in the atmosphere. In metropolitan cities where mechanized traffic has reached an alarming stage, the menace of air pollution is the greatest. Deforestation on a large scale has further led to serious consequences. The capacity of nature to clean the environment by its own means has been hit hard by deforestation. Deforestation has also led to destruction of wild life. Thus the modern man has appeared to be sworn enemy of the flora and fauna, which play a crucial role in maintaining ecological balance.

The pollution menace is further heightened by atmospheric pollution caused by noise. Noise has been recognized as one of the great pollutants in so far as it affects our health very adversely.

BACKWARD CLASS UPLIFTMENT PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. The school is run for students of Backward and Other Backward classes of the society. The society also imparts free education to 20 students and provides scholarship for meritorious students of the lowest rung of the society on economic ladder. The coaching is run for students of class I-VI.
