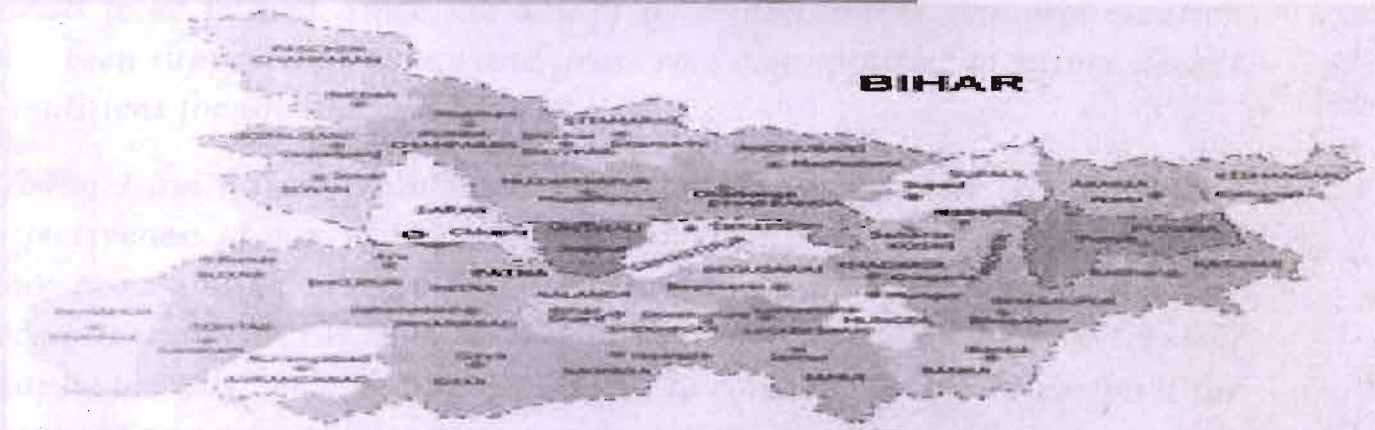
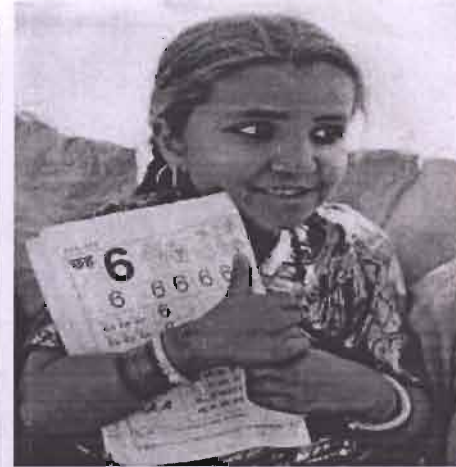

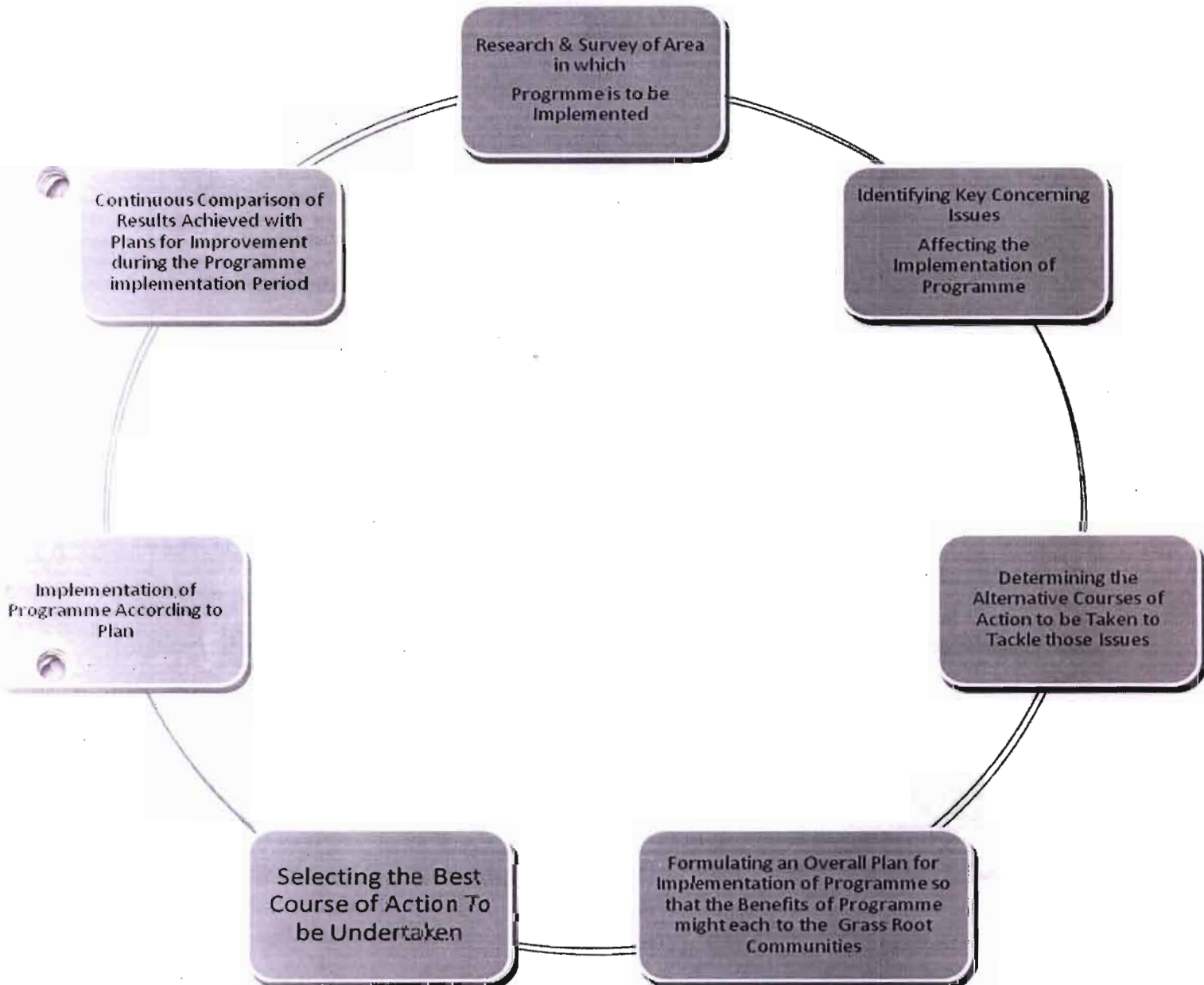

During the period under review the Financial, Physical Performance are as under:

PHYSICAL PERFORMANCE

CHILD LABOUR AWARENESS PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. The initiatives and support for the Eradication of Child Labour in India, through the government sector, non-government sector, judiciary, social workers and public at large has raised hopes for creating mass movement against the menace of child labour and provide universal compulsory education for children. Several legislations have been passed from time to time to prohibit or improve the working conditions of child labour. Legislation relating to the regulation of child labour concentrates mainly on four basic issues;

- **Minimum age for employment of children,**
- **Maximum period of work per day and forbidding work at night**
- **Prohibition of certain types of work for children, and**
- **Medical examination of all working children.**

A Child Labour Technical Advisory Committee has been setup to advise the Central Government in addition of occupations and processes to the schedule contained in the child labour. The committee was empowered to undertake reviews and frame rules as necessary to ensure that the work is regulated in accordance with part.

GIRLS EDUCATION PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. The organization conducted the girls education programme for the rural girls and women. Adolescent girls and matured girls are educated and trained by the organization to develop the business skills and production of commercial goods in their own home. Education especially for women is an important agent of socialization, and instrument of social transformation, and a channel of social mobility and equity. Education of girls and women has to be a universal movement for their empowerment, for changing current stereo-typed and replacing the existing structures.

Within an overall orientation toward girls' education, OUR organisation is running this Programme being one of the parts of overall strategy of universalisation of Elementary Education.

POOR CHILD EDUCATION PROGRAMME

The society conducted child poor education programme in Patna district of Bihar state. The programme was conducted for the students of the school and were encouraged for artisans. OUR society organized Finance Assistance to Poor Artists Programme to help poor and merited students who cannot able to continue their hobby because of poorness. Society selected merited poor students through the organize competition programme of music and fine arts programme in small level at Patna district in state of Bihar. For participate poor students, participating fee is never taken by society. Main aim of society organize this programme is taking munch for poor and merited students showing their skill and financial support who taking interest in music and fine arts.

EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. Education is a prime determinant of human development. Progress of a community in education may be viewed from several angles and hence different indices of educational achievement may be used. The conventional indices include (i) effective literacy rate (ii) primary school enrolment rate (iii) drop-out rate at the primary level (iv) mean years of schooling at the primary level (v) pupil- teacher ratio and (vi) distance of schools from place of residence.

AIDS AWARENESS PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. Among the methods adopted, female sterilization predominates as 21.4 percent of the eligible women had unmet need is for spacing birth and the remains for limiting the children. A majority of the male respondents indicated progresses for female method. They did not prefer the male methods mainly because of the fear of weakness due to the was of male method, fear of method failure and fear of operation It was decided to prepare a wide AIDS scheme for the coverage of family planning programme by the society. Local doctors and Para-medical workers have extended their useful co-operation in diffusion of the requisite

knowledge about family planning methods to the eligible couples with intrusive comparing in the district.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. Managing committee of the society decided to start vocational training programme for self-employment. That training programme is aims to equip rural youth in the age group 18-35 years with the skills and technology required for self-employment. Society allowed relaxation of age certain special conditions, especially in the case of carpet weavers, lepers, the disabled, pensioners and widows. For develop youth entrepreneurship society choose Home based industries like handicrafts, Beedi industry, Agarbatti making, Tailoring and Garment. Under these programmes society teach & training of rural youth for self-employment during this year under this programme 56 persons benefited and able to self reliance and our society have aims to working increase more than hundred people benefits next year and develop their infrastructure.

SANITATION PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. Sanitation is a very important issue that leads that leads to many other related problems. Our society has been worked in the field of Construction of Latrines in Patna District. Society make Temporary toilets (for Camps etc,) (i) Shallow trench (ii) Deep trench (iii) Pit privy (iv) Bored hole privy. Low cost sanitation systems for the rural areas (and urban areas which have developed without any consideration to scientific planning) should be installed, e.g., aquaprivies, septic tanks, composting toilets, etc. Priorities in sanitation should be to provide people with sanitation facilities so that water does not get contaminated and does not harm health.

HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. The family welfare programme started by the society with the objective of reducing the birth rate to the extent necessary to stabilise the population at a level consistent with the requirements of the National Economy.

Society organized family welfare programme in many places of Bihar states. The literacy rate of the states are very low and the need of aware of the people fact that a small family is a healthy one. The effectively couple protected.

About this programme main view of the society is to provide family planning services within the broader context of maternal and child health care. It disseminates information and education to enable couples to make voluntary informed choices regarding size of the family and spacing through contraception.

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. Economic empowerment is a sine qua non for elevating the status of women in our society. One possible approach towards achieving this end could be through entrepreneurship development. Through entrepreneurship development a women will not only generate income for herself but also generate employment for other women in the locality. This will have a multiplier effect in the generation of income and poverty alleviation. According to society many causes of poverty in India and which main causes are poor status of women, less job opportunity & low productivity and low income are make vicious circle of poverty.

BACKWARD CLASS UPLIFTMENT PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. The Backward Classes Welfare Department, a Department under the Govt. of West Bengal is working towards sustainable development of the persons belonging to the Schedules Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes of West Bengal. The main aim of the Department is to improve the quality of life of these socially and economically backward classes and enhancement of capability of the people belonging to these communities, so that they can be very much part & parcel of the mainstream of the Society.

- To promote and implement educational schemes for upliftment, of SC, ST and Other Backward Classes including training leading to self-employment.

- To supervise issue of caste certificates and enforce reservation rules in services & posts under the Govt. , Public Undertakings , Statutory Bodies Universities , Colleges, Schools, Local Authorities, and Govt. aided offices and institutions.
- To work for their social and cultural development.
- To implement schemes for their economic upliftment and development of Human Resources.
- To strengthen infrastructure and create community assets in SC/ST dominated areas.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

Organization executed many other programmes and people got benefited in large scale. Some information has also been recorded from different localities for future use.
