Our Executive Committee takes pleasure in presenting Annual Report for the year ending 31st March 2012 along with Audited Annual Accounts for the year ended on that date. During the year under review, the following are our achievements.

ACTIVITIES & PROGRAMMES

CHILD LABOUR WELFARE PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. Our constitution makers had known that India of their vision would not be a reality if the country's children are not nurtured and educated. Article 24 dealing with prohibition of employment of children in factories and Article 45 relating to provision of free compulsory education for children bear testimony to this realisation. The other prohibition of traffic in human beings and forced labour (Article 23) and certain principles of policy to be followed by the State stipulates that children be secured against exploitation.

Child labour in India is more of a rural than urban phenomenon. Approximately, 90 percent of the working children in the rural areas are employed in agriculture and allied activities. The unorganised and informal sectors, both in urban and informal sectors, both in urban and rural areas, account for almost the entire child labour force. The incidence of child labour is partly linked to the level of socio-economic development of an area and partly to the attitude and approach of parents of the child labourers as a result of socio-economic development of an area and partly to the attitude and approach of parents of the child labourers as a result of socio-economic compulsions. According to the 1991 census, the number of working children in the country was 11.28 million.

GIRLS EDUCATION PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. Education especially for women is an important agent of socialization, and instrument of social transformation, and a channel of social mobility and equity. Education of girls and women has to be a universal movement for their empowerment, for changing current stereo-typed and replacing the existing structures.

Within an overall orientation toward girls' education, OUR organisation is running this Programme being one of the parts of overall strategy of universalisation of Elementary Education. This is an alternative path to children who for different reasons cannot attend primary school e.g. girls who have to look after their younger siblings and attend to other domenic chores, working children etc.

POOR CHILD EDUCATION PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. The programme was conducted for the students of the school and were encouraged for artisans. OUR society organized Finance Assistance to Poor Artists Programme to help poor and merited students who cannot able to continue their hobby because of poorness. Society selected merited poor students through the organize competition programme of music and fine arts programme in small level at Patnadistrict in state of Bihar. For participate poor students, participating fee is never taken by society. Main aim of society organize this programme is taking munch for poor and merited students showing their skill and financial support who taking interest in music and fine arts.

EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. Education is a prime determinant of human development. Progress of a community in education may be viewed from several angles and hence different indices of educational achievement may be used. The conventional indices include (i) effective literacy rate (ii) primary school enrolment rate (iii) drop-out rate at the primary level (iv) mean years of schooling at the primary level (v) pupil- teacher ratio and (vi) distance of schools from place of residence.

AIDS AWARENESS PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. India is sitting on an AIDS "time-bomb" and the epidemic could soon become like it in Africa unless immediate steps are taken to accelerate efforts to stem it. This is the warning from the head of an international survey agency. "The AIDS deadly disease in India is extremely grave. It is ticking time bomb. The epidemic is rising rapidly and could soon get out of control, unless the response was scaled up massively."

The trajectory of the epidemic in India is the same as that in Africa and though the current level of the epidemic here may be 10 to 15 years behind that in Africa, it may not be long before it catches up. The catastrophic situation being faced in Botswana and other parts of Southern Africa "is just a vision of the future" that India could face. In Bihar, for instance, no one knows how many persons are affected.

OUR society accepted the need participating of community and social workers for minimize this problem. Without participating and involvement of the corporate sector, the NGOs and community-based organizations the Government would not be able to tackle the problem all by itself and more effectively in anti-AIDS programmes.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. OUR Organization has been running vocational training programme for welfare women, child and youths belonging to the informal economy. It is not just an

organization but also a confluence of three movements- labour, self-reliance and self-employment. Our Society started vocational training programme to encourage self-reliance and self-employment for women and youths who were unemployed and searching job. In this programme Society started all educated and uneducated persons in view of their requirements. Under vocational training programme our Society-started computer training, typing, handcrafting, tailoring-sewing, weaving, painting, T.V., Transistor and Tape-recorder repairing programmes.

SANITATION PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. Health status has a direct link with the availability of safe drinking water and sanitation. Apart from direct benefits in terms of protection from infection, these facilities also free women and children from the burden of carrying water over long distances.

With increasing inputs in successive Five Year Plans, India has been able to provide access to safe drinking water to 74 per cent of families in rural and 85 per cent of families in the urban areas. However, there are still a large number of problem village where there is no distances. of safe drinking water of which are facing shortage of water.

HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. Population stabilization has been a priority area for sustaining the process of economic development in the country. This has been also the focus of successive five-year plans. Bihar lags behind not only in containing population growth to manageable limits but also in realizing the goals fixed on the health front.

As we know that the increased access to equality health care services has been one of the thrust areas of the social development programmes being undertaken in the country. Technological advances and the extension in the infrastructure network has resulted in a decline in mortality. But the burden of disease continues to be important. Our Society organized a series of health camps on a regular basis in different districts of Bihar.

WOMEN AWARENESS PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. Our NGO believes that economic empowerment of women transforms them into powerful agents of social change. NGO, women's empowerment programme is helping several thousand rural women like Sarita add to their family income. NGO organizes rural women into micro-credit groups and provides them funds to build and manage a revolving development fund. These groups extend financial support to members, to set up small businesses, enabling them evolve into entrepreneurs. Over the next decade, these micro-credit groups will have about 600 member's, creating thousands more women entrepreneurs. What's more, NGO also imparts training to improve their vocational skills. Enhancing their

employability to supplement family income. Leading to better health care, nutrition and education for their children.

NGO women's empowerment programme emanates from its aspiration to create enduring value for the nation. For NGO, it is yet another expression of a commitment beyond the market. Of a conviction that country must come before corporation for a true pride in being Citizen First.

BACKWARD CLASS UPLIFTMENT PROGRAMME

The organisation conducted the programme in Patna District of Bihar State. The school is run for students of Backward and Other Backward classes of the society. The society also imparts free education to 20 students and provides scholarship for meritorious students of the lowest rung of the society on economic ladder. The coaching is run for students of class I-VI.
